Outdoor Spring Class Protocols

In-person, outdoor classes will require some extra precautions for the protection of everyone. Please click the link and read before registering.

- The teacher will take the temperature of adults and children with a contact-less, forehead thermometer.
- 6' spacing is required for social distancing. Bring a waterproof-backed blanket you can place on the ground and take home with you. The blanket area is your personal space. There may be dew on the ground, especially with the 9:30 classes. You will want waterproofing.
- Per the CDC guidelines, we require all adults to wear masks and children 2 years of age and older. Remember, we are singing. The teacher will be wearing a mask.
- As always, the adult needs to monitor for the child's safety in the outside area.
- Sanitizing: Each family will have a designated, sanitized family instrument bag with their name on it. If you choose, it is the responsibility of each family to sanitize the instruments with a wipe provided at class or one of your choosing. Each week, the teacher will bring the labeled bags to class, so each family receives the same sanitized instruments.
- Raining? If weather does not permit us to be outdoors, we will make every effort to reschedule, but may need to move it to a virtual class. Here is hoping for sunshine!

Following the above protocols should make everyone feel safe participating and enjoying our outdoor music classes. If you or your child is feeling ill, has a fever or chills, do not attend class. Let's keep everyone safe!
